SCHOOL DAY – PART 2

- Everyday starts at 8.40am for all our pupils.
- Detailed timings of our school day:

SCHOOL DAY – PART 3

- Lessons finish at 3.00pm and we extend a warm welcome to all pupils who wish to stay for Power Hour Activities which are academic, cultural and sporting.
- If pupils remain in school for Power Hour Activities the school day will end at 4.00pm.











LUNCHTIME

- There is 3/4 hour for lunch.
- There is plenty of choice from: cooked dinner of the day, jacket potatoes and lots of fillings, sandwiches, hot and cold baguettes, wraps, pizza, fruit, yogurts, water and fruit juice.
- We also have a breakfast club which is open to all pupils at 8am, serving tea and toast.
- At break, you can have toast and bacon rolls as well as cold drinks.





CASHLESS CATERING

- Maesteg operates a cashless catering system for school meals. It is a biometric system that recognises the thumb print of your child at the tills and at the revaluation pay points. This means that no cash will be accepted at the Till Points in the canteen.
- Currently there are two payment options available:

On-line payments; Coin and note payments at the revaluation pay-points situation in the school atrium.

- Parent-Pay: access child's account to see what he/she is having for lunch and at break. Can make payments wherever you see Pay Point Sign (Filco and Premier Local Shops)







TEACHING CLASSES

- They will be with 3 different teachers for most of their timetable following our new year 7 Challenge Curriculum.
- They will have different teachers for Maths, French, Welsh and PE.

HOUSE TUTOR GROUPS

- There will 2 tutors with every tutor group
- There will be a designated a House Section of the School
- All year 6 pupils carefully sorted into mixed year tutor groups.
- Tutor time will last for up to 20 minutes a day.
- Year 6 pupils will have the benefit of being table to talk to pupils who have experienced year 7 and the transition to Maesteg School.
