Examination Results Day 2020

Results Day – Thursday 13th August 2020

Due to the social distancing restrictions placed on schools as a result of the current coronavirus pandemic, we have regrettably taken the decision to amend our usual procedures for pupils collecting their results this summer. We still feel it is important that all pupils have the opportunity to attend school to collect their results in person but it is also important that this is managed in a way that is safe for all students and staff. As a result, year 13 students will be allocated a time and entrance to the school where they will be able collect their results.

Pupils will receive their results as detailed in the table below:

Year 13 – Thursday 13th August:

House	Collection Time	Entrance Doors
Cadrawd (Yellow House)	9.00 – 11.00	Enter through Main Reception
Cynwyd (Red House)	9.00 – 11.00	Enter through Coffee reception
Daren (Green House)	9.00 – 11.00	Enter through PE doors at the bottom of the PE corridor
Llynfi (Blue House)	9.00 – 11.00	Enter through Pupil Reception

During this collection time we ask for your support in ensuring the following:

- Please ensure that you attend school only through your allocated entrance and during the allocated hours of 9-11 am. **Pupils will not be allowed on school site before 9:00 and after 11:00.** This will enable staff to ensure that safe and effective social distancing is practiced
- A one-way system will be in place in school when students are collecting their results. This system will be monitored by school staff.
- This one-way system will also be in operation after results have been collected and students will leave through an allocated exit door. We are asking that students adhere to the system and leave school site immediately after receiving their results.
- In order to try and limit the number of individuals in the school building at any one time, we have regrettably taken the decision to allow **only students who are receiving their results to have access to the school building** on these days. This will mean that any parents/relatives who accompany their children will need to remain in the school car park/yard while students collect their results

- Pupils will also receive the results via their school email address at 1pm on Results Day, should they not be in a position to pick their results up during the collection time.
- We regret that examination results can only be sent to the pupil's school email address and cannot be sent to the email address of parents/carers.
- Finally, should your child require support with UCAS Clearing on receiving their results, your child will be able to make an appointment with Mr Brooks and Natalie Baker (Careers Wales) on Thursday 13th August.
