
YEAR 12 – AS RESULTS







Having received AS grades today, pupils have naturally raised queries regarding their options in progressing into Year 13 and/or appealing against the grade awarded.

Firstly, all pupils can apply to the school for freedom of information on the Centre Assessed Grades the school submitted to the examination board. Anyone wishing to do this can email Mr Chris Brooks, requesting the form, which then needs to be returned to school so the data can be released.

Secondly, pupils who wish to appeal the AS grade awarded or the Centre Assessed Grade would need to apply to the school via email (maesteg@bridgend.gov.uk) for the form to submit an appeal. Staff will be available next Wednesday (19th August) to deal with any appeal queries for AS grades.

To reassure pupils concerned about AS grades and subsequent University applications, AS grades will not contribute towards the final A level grade for each subject. All final A level grades will be awarded based on A2 Year 13 exam results.
