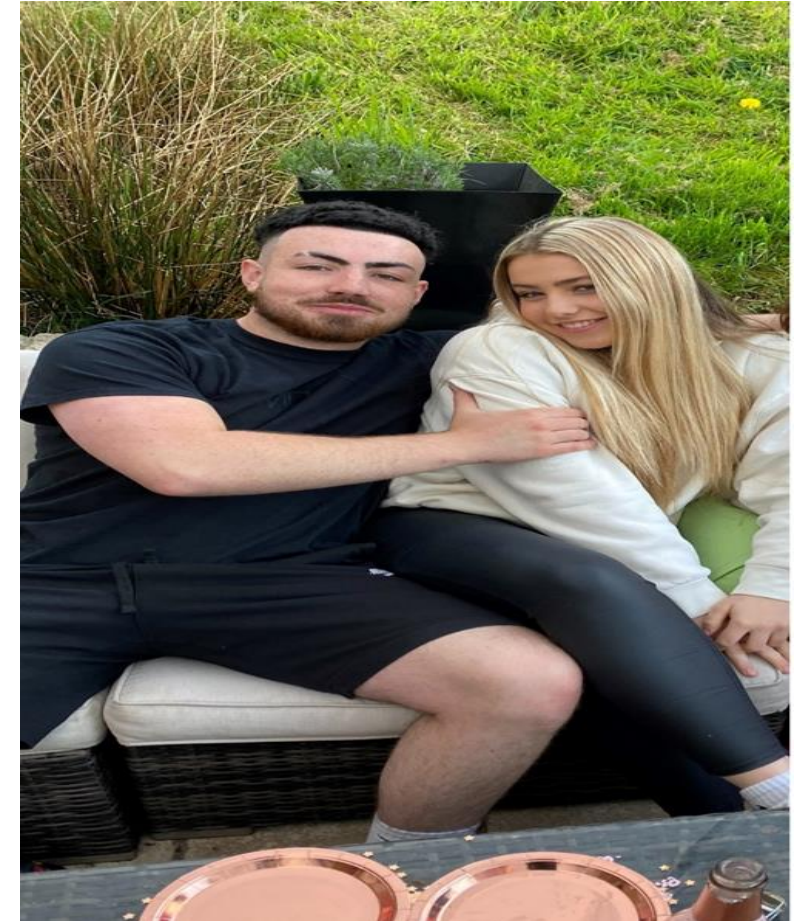

Oxbridge and Seren



To support our more able and talented learners we offer two programmes of tailored support.

New College Oxford's prestigious Step-Up programme is designed to inspire and support state-school students throughout Year 11, 12 and 13.

It attempts to ensure that students recognise Oxford as a realistic and achievable option for them in the future and are fully equipped and supported to make a competitive application.

Crucially, it is a sustained-contact scheme. Students have regular, consistent contact with the College's Outreach team over three years (two years for students attending a sixth form college). The programme is fully funded.

Seren Academy - The Seren Academy provides unique opportunities to receive direct advice from university admissions tutors on how to apply to leading universities, develop competitive personal statements, prepare for admissions tests and approach interviews. The Seren Academy invites the brightest and most academically able learners in years 12 and 13 across Wales to join the programme. As part of the programme, learners will take part in a range of interactive activities and study experiences designed to support their learning. Learners will also receive expert guidance to help them make informed decisions as they prepare for university.
